We have our Christmas party on Friday 20th December so please come in your party clothes. We may have a special visitor too!

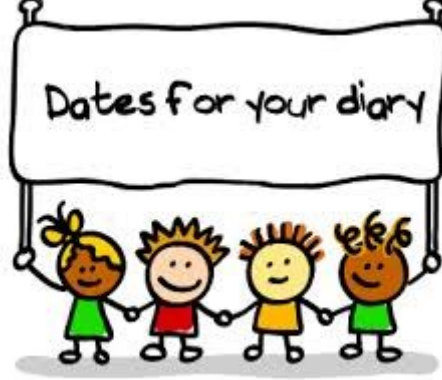
