Healthy Lunchboxes

We have been reviewing the lunchboxes that the children bring to nursery. We must emphasise that children need a variety of food groups and that some children have so much in their boxes that they do not know where to begin. We also have snack daily in nursery, twice a day for 30 hour children. No chocolate should be in lunchboxes.
